

RESOURCE CENTRE


The Resource Centre is a facility of the campus where students can explore academic and career resources.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission to 50% of the seats are given to the merit candidates according to the University regulations and the remaining 50% are filled by the management. Selection to the merit seats is done by the University of Calicut through a single window programme.

Application Form for Management Quota

- The candidate seeking for admission under the management quota should apply in separate application form which can be had from the management office on payment of Rs. 150.
- The filled application can be submitted at the office or send by post.
- University CAP registration is compulsory for all categories of admission including management quota.
- r Original Certificates are to be produced at the time of admission.
- Parent/Guardian should accompany the candidate at the time of admission.

A candidate selected should appear for interview with the following

1. Admit Card.

- 2. SSLC (Original and Three Photocopies)
- Qualifying Certificates (Original and Three Photocopies of +2 or equivalent or Degree Mark List as the case may be).
 Original Transfer Certificate (T.C) from the institution last attended.
 Original Conduct Certificate from the institution last attended.
- 6. Passport size Photograph (Three Copies).

Candidate from universities other than University of Calicut should also produce the following documents at the time of admission.

- 1. Migration Certificate.
- 2. Eligibility/Equivalency Certificate from the University of Calicut.
- 3. Course Certificate.
- 4. Pass Certificate.

















GENERAL RULES

- The working hours of the college are from 9:30 am to 3.30pm
- Students should behave with dignity and courtesy in and outside the campus
- Students shall be fully aware that the loss of classes will affect their future and hence they shall attend classes regularly.
- Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the campus
- Only two-wheelers are permitted to the students for bringing to the college and should wear helmet.
- They should park the vehicle in the space allotted
- Indecent behaviour towards teachers and fellow students is uncompromisable.
- The decision of the principal against disciplinary action is final
- Any kind of disturbing behaviour / causing damage to college amenities and public property on the campus is offensive and will be treated seriously.
- Any ill-treatment both physical and verbal, based on gender, caste, and religion will be treated as serious disciplinary issue.

The students should enter the college dressed properly in uniform

Uniform is compulsory for all students on all days including days of examinations and special classes

All the students must wear Identity Card on all days including days of examinations, special classes. A student without the ID card will not be allowed to enter the college campus





Ragging is prohibited in the campus.

The students are warned that as per the provisions of the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act 1998 and the order of the University of Calicut, ragging within or outside the college is strictly prohibited. If any students found guilty on the parameters of the law of ragging, he or she shall be punished for 2 years of imprisonment along with fine. Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 of the Act shall be dismissed from the institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institutions for a period of 3 years from the date of order of such dismissal.













FEE STRUCTURE


- ▼ University approved tuition fees for each programme will be collected
