


BLOOD DONATION CAMP




REPORT OF SHEHARAMAM

The NSS (National Service Scheme) volunteers Planed to organize a community service program aimed at enhancing the public amenities in our locality. The program focused on three key activities: painting the community well, renovating the Mathrka bus stop, and cleaning and painting the banyan tree area. This report summarizes the planning, execution, and outcomes of these activities. The community well was cleaned thoroughly before applying a fresh coat of paint. Volunteers ensured the area was left clean and free from debris. The bus stop shelter was repaired, including fixing the damaged seating area. The entire structure was painted, and new signage was installed. The area around the banyan tree was cleaned of all litter and debris. - To clean and beautify the area around the banyan tree, promoting environmental awareness.












ZERO PLASTIC POOKKATTIRI




